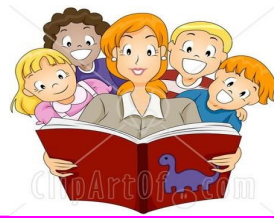
A big THANK YOU to all the families and staff who supported our recent book fair.
