


Looking forward to a great 2017

From Our Principal

Hello Everyone,

Welcome to 2017. I hope that you have all had a fantastic break and are feeling ready for a great year.



Over the break we managed to complete a lot of work around the school. Some of the things you may have noticed are the new carpet, painted hallways, installation of the new shade sails, the covered walkway between the gym and performing arts centre as well as the beginning of the new office. We have also had some old air conditioners removed and new air conditioners installed, roof leaks repaired and old heaters removed.

The new reading shed is completed and will begin in week 3. We are still waiting on the shade sail for the playground, some classrooms to be painted, the remaining old air conditioners and heaters to be removed and the playground line marking to be done. Over the next holiday break the administration office will be completed.

The canteen is almost ready to go since being painted, having a coffee machine and other new equipment installed. We are just waiting on the fridges and the food so we can open.

You will be notified when the canteen will be opening and a menu and pricelist will be sent out. There is a lot of learning that occurs when schools have a canteen. Two of the protocols that children must understand are the way we line up and how to exchange money. In order to ensure that the canteen is a positive place for everyone we will have a staged opening.

Next week the canteen will be open on Monday, Wednesday and Friday lunchtimes for counter sales of Zooper Doopers. These will sell for \$1.00 each. Children will need to remain in the court yard outside the canteen while they eat their food. If your child would like to purchase a Zooper Dooper next week they will need to have their money so they can bring it to the canteen at lunch time.

From Our Principal

We will also have the canteen open on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 8:30-9:30am for parents who would like to come and purchase a cappuccino, latte or hot chocolate. These will sell for \$4 each and will only be sold to adults. It should be a good opportunity to come and meet other parents.



We are a Sunsmart School and therefore need to ensure that all of our children and staff are protected from the harsh sun. Broad brimmed or legionnaires hats must be worn during the risk season of 1st September to 1st May each year. This will be all of first term and the first two weeks of term 2.

This year we would like to send some students to the District Swimming Carnival. This is an event where students compete against swimmers from other schools. It is only for students who are 9 years old or older. They must have or be currently attending weekly swimming lessons and be able to swim a minimum of 50m continuously, of an appropriate swimming stroke. If you believe your child would be able to represent PCS at this event, please complete the form in this newsletter so Ms Gardiner can register them. Registrations close next week.

On Wednesday 15th February we will be having an open night. This is a great opportunity for parents and families to come and see your child's classroom and meet their teacher. You can have a look around the school and find out about how our classrooms operate. I look forward to seeing many of you on this night.

We have provided a hard copy of this newsletter to each family at PCS. Future newsletters will be published on our website. If you require a hard copy of future newsletters please contact the staff at the school administration office.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We will be running "Feeling is Thinking" in Term 2 and 3 here at the school. This program is run for Grade 3 to 6 students (depending on numbers).

We would like to offer this group to your child/children in your care. We will be running this group during school time at the school.

The group is to assist children with their relationships and in expressing their feelings.

This group is facilitated in small groups (no more than 8 children) and focuses on issues such as exploring feelings, strong emotions: what do they look like?, what things make people angry, managing anger, taking risks and practising changes.

Feeling is Thinking runs for eight weeks and each session is for one hour. The group concludes with a 'Celebration' session.

Feeling is Thinking will be facilitated by myself and Kelly Dow, our Primary Welfare Officer. If you think your son or daughter (or child in your care) would benefit from Feeling is Thinking we would encourage you to talk to him/her about this. Should you both decide that they would like to participate please return the reply slip to myself as soon as possible.

There will be a \$10.00 fee for this Program to help with the costs of the journals that your child will receive. Once your child has been placed into a group you will receive a confirmation letter and a request for payment. Please do not send payment until you receive this request.

Seasons For Growth

Dear Parents/Carer,

Change and loss are issues that affect all of us at some stage in our lives. At Pakenham Consolidated School we recognise that when changes occur in families through death, separation, divorce or related circumstances, young people may benefit from learning how to manage these changes effectively. We are therefore offering a very successful educational Program called Seasons for Growth. This Program is facilitated in small groups of up to 8 children (with a minimum of 4 – 5 in each group before the program can in Grades 3 & 4 and level 3 is for children in Grades 1 & 2, level 2 is for children in Grades 3 & 4 and level 3 is for children in Grades 5 & 6. The Program is based on research that highlights the importance of social support and the need to practise new skills to cope effectively with change and loss. The Program focuses on issues such as self-esteem, managing feelings, problem-solving, decision-making, effective communication and support networks.

The Seasons for Growth Program is made up of a one hour session, once a week, over an eight week period. The Program then concludes with a 'celebration' session.

Seasons for Growth is facilitated by myself, and Kelly Dow our Primary Welfare Officer. We have received special training in the use of this Program. If you think your son/daughter would benefit from Seasons for Growth we would encourage you to talk to him/her about this. Should he/she decide to participate please fill in the attached form and return it to me in the Community Hub as soon as possible.

There will be a \$10.00 fee for this Program to help with the costs of the journals that your child will receive. Once your child has been placed into a group you will receive a confirmation letter and a request for payment. Please do not send payment until you receive this request.
